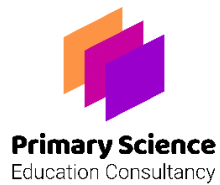








	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div style="width: 48%;"> <p><b>Child</b></p> <p>As they get older they became a child. When they are a child they learn and developed more and more. They get taller, bigger and gain weight but they still in the same shape. However they cannot be responsible for their self they need someone to looked after them. They still need to learn and they understand what is right or wrong when they get older.</p> </div> <div style="width: 48%;"> <p><b>Adolescent ( Puberty )</b></p> <p>Between 9 to 13 years people go through puberty. Hormones are these chemicals that affect your body such as getting emotional quickly and it is physical. Females puberty is when your hips get wider (to grow a baby), breasts bigger, getting hair on your body, having periods, spots and you are able to have a baby. Males have similar puberty. Males have spots, sperms, chest widen, get taller, having hair around their body and especially on their face. They are able to make babies also at 9 years old if they start puberty.</p>  </div> </div>	<p>The PowerPoint slides show that Melissa can describe the changes as humans develop to old age.</p>

	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div style="width: 48%;"> <p><b>Mature adult</b></p> <p>When you are a mature adult, you are responsible for yourself and you stop growing taller. They go to work. Women stop having periods when they are older and cannot have children.</p>  </div> <div style="width: 48%;"> <p><b>Older Adult</b></p> <p>Some older adult get grey and white hair and their bones get weaker, sometimes lose their memory, cannot move easily and get health problems. When some adults get older, sometimes they cannot think as fast.</p>  </div> </div>
